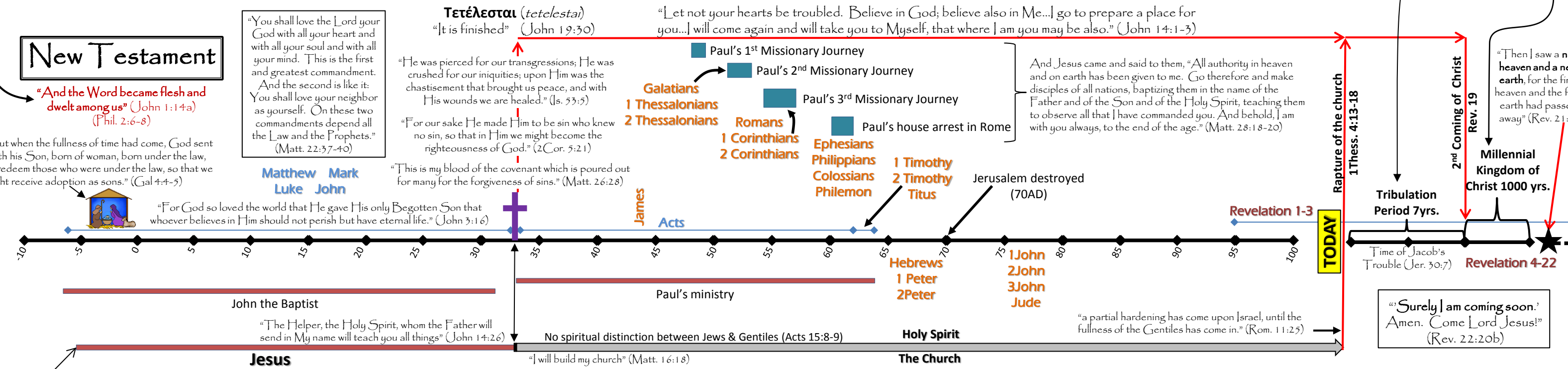
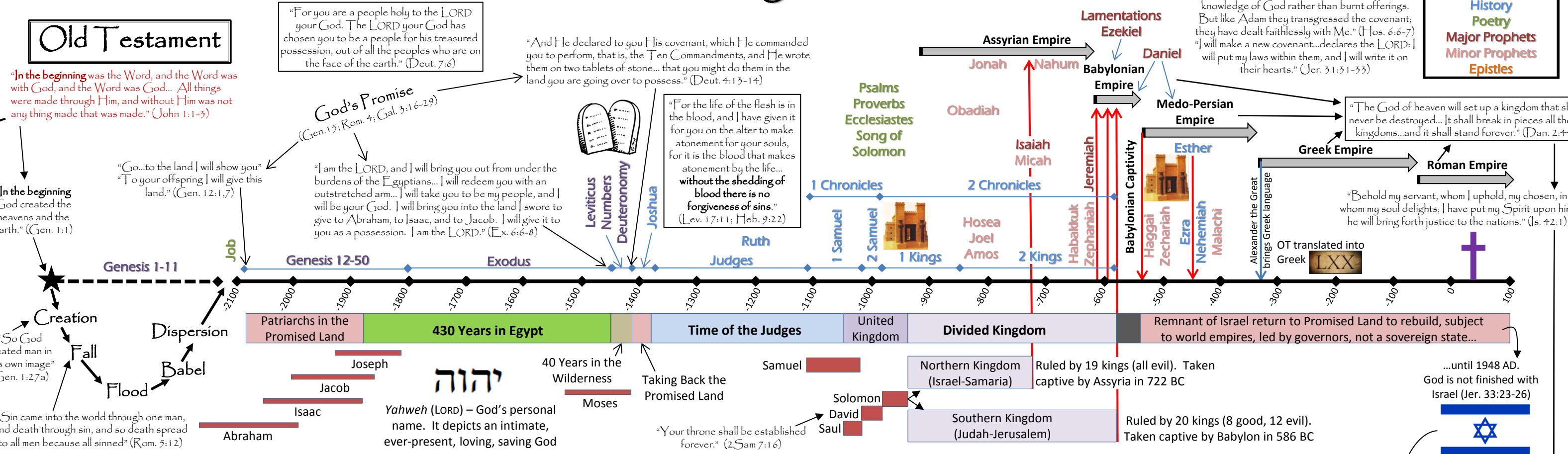
The Person & Work of Jesus Christ
